



Our life is a gift from God and we are stewards of every other gift that comes with life. Therefore, our Orthodox Christian stewardship is an act of gratitude toward the only giver of life. In the Divine Liturgy, we proclaim this saying: "Thine own of Thine own, we offer unto thee in behalf of all and for all."

In earlier times, devout Christians brought the first fruits of their harvest to the church, thanking God for his generosity. Bread, the product of wheat, and wine, the juice of their vines, were the necessary products to sustain life in agricultural societies for an entire year outside the harvest seasons.

Today, we continue to offer bread and wine during the liturgy to be transformed to the precious body and blood of our savior Jesus Christ; however, we now buy the flour and wine and are disconnected from the labor, physical and emotional, to produce them.
